

# The Yarn Patch

## Macrame Like Hanging Envelope

Finished size: approx. 7" x 8" (not including fringe)

**Materials:** 1 Skein KFI Collection Macrame Cotton, makes 2.

**Gauge:** 5.5 stitches per 4 inches

**Hook:** 15.00 mm hook, or size to make gauge. If your tension is much tighter than the designer, you'll have difficulty working the stitches. If it's much looser, you may not have enough yardage to make 2 hangings.

### Abbreviations:

Ch - Chain

Sc - Single Crochet

### Pattern

Leaving at least 5 inches of a tail, chain 3, sc in third chain from hook.

**Row 1:** Ch1, turn. 2 sc in each stitch (4 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch1, turn, 2 sc, sc in each stitch to last, 2 sc in last stitch

**Row 3 - 7:** Repeat row 2 6 times total, you will have 16 sc when you finish this last repeat.

**Row 8:** You will now join in the round. Sc in the first stitch in the opposite corner of the triangle of row 7. This should start to make an envelope shape. SC 19 more. You should now be at the corner of the envelope.

**Row 9:** Turn, SC both sides of envelope bottom together, bringing your hook from the outside of the fabric as shown in the picture to the right.

**Finishing:** Cut lengths of yarn approximately 10" long, fold in half. Pull fold through one of the bottom single crochets from front to back, bring the fold toward the front and pull the cut ends through the fold. Tug on the ends to tighten. Repeat this process for each bottom single crochet. Weave in the end from the starting chain, leaving a small loop for hanging.

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
